### SAFETY INFORMATION

### WARNING

- 1. Unplug the fan before moving it or performing maintenance.
- 2. DO NOT touch the fan when your hands are wet.
- 3. Those who are not qualified electricians should not disassemble, repair or rebuild the fan.
- 3. Unplug the fan when it is not in use.
- 4. DO NOT unplug the fan by holding the cable cord. Unplug by holding the plug.
- 5. DO NOT use the fan when there is damage to the cable cord or plug.
- 6. DO NOT use the fan with extension cord.
- 7. DO NOT use the fan close to fire.
- 8. DO NOT insert your hand or other objects into the guard or the movable parts.


### CAUTION

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Unplug the appliance before cleaning. Don't use any water for cleaning metal surfaces. Slightly moisten a cloth and then wipe off the surfaces of the fan. In order to remove the dust from the grill, use a vacuum cleaner or remove the front grill by removing the securing screw on the edge of the grill with a screwdriver. After cleaning, remount the grill. After doing this, fasten the securing screw on the edge of the grill.

### WHEELS ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



The 24" fan (Item #736485) is fully assembled. When you get from the package carton.

The 30" fan (Item #736486), the 36" fan (Item# 736487) and the 42" fan (Item# 736488) need to assemble the wheel after your getting from the package carton.


- 1. Insert the two wheels into the two holes on the bracket. (1)
- 2. Insert the screw to the hole on the wheel shaft then tighten it. (2)

### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**


- 1. Place the fan on a safe, flat surface where it can not fall or be pulled by the cord.
- 2. Plug unit into electrical outlet.
- 3. Select preferred speed (1-Low, 2-High) by rotating or pressing the switch knob or button on the control box.
- 4. Always turn off and unplug fan after using.
